Dan Flavin Tribute Exhibition

to be presented at the Margo Leavin Gallery

18 January – 22 February 1997

Margo Leavin Gallery is pleased to present an exhibition of work by Dan Flavin. The exhibition has been organized in tribute to the artist, who died in December 1996, and will include signature works dating from the 1960s through the 1980s. The exhibition will be on view at the Robertson Boulevard Gallery from 18 January through 22 February 1997.

Dan Flavin's ground-breaking work used commercial fluorescent lights to create environments exploring light, color and space. Included in the exhibition will be an example from Flavin's seminal 1960s body of work, *Monuments to V. Tatlin*, which paid homage to Vladimir Tatlin, the turn of the century avant-garde Soviet artist and architect. In addition, the exhibition will feature other important works from the 1960s through the 1980s, including a 1987 work created in honor of Donald Judd.

Dan Flavin: A Tribute will mark the third exhibition of Flavin's work at Margo Leavin Gallery.

Margo Leavin Gallery is located at 812 North Robertson Boulevard in Los Angeles.
Gallery hours are 11 a.m. to 5 p.m., Tuesday through Sunday.
