New works to be presented at
Margo Leavin Gallery
14 June – 12 July, 2003

The Margo Leavin Gallery is pleased to announce an exhibition of new works on paper by William Leavitt. This will be the artist's third exhibition with the gallery.

Los Angeles based artist William Leavitt has a historically diverse body of work, which includes installation, theatre, painting, and works on paper. In the new collage-like drawings, Leavitt achieves a theatrical tone by parading objects and figures across backdrops of landscapes or cityscapes. Combinations of devices used to disguise academic representation create nascent stories which are completed by the viewer.

William Leavitt was born in Washington, D.C. He graduated with a BFA from the University of Colorado, Boulder, and went on to receive his MFA at the Claremont Graduate School in California. His work can be found in important permanent collections, including the Museum of Contemporary Art, Los Angeles, and the San Diego Museum of Contemporary Art, La Jolla.
