**Brenna Youngblood**

Margo Leavin Gallery is pleased to announce an exhibition of new work by Brenna Youngblood, on view from 19 May to 23 June. This will be Youngblood's first solo exhibition at the gallery and in Los Angeles.

Youngblood's work encompasses both abstraction and representation through vivid and evocative images. Intimate and complex, her work explores the relationship of common objects and the space they occupy in our collective memory. Youngblood's own photographs are cut, altered and layered with and placed within fields of paint and various other materials. The results are visual metaphors that are tense and chaotically beautiful.

Brenna Youngblood was born in Riverside, CA and currently lives and works in Los Angeles. She received her MFA from University of California, Los Angeles in 2006. She has had solo projects at the Hammer Museum, Los Angeles as well as the Wignall Museum at Chaffey College in Rancho Cucamonga, CA. Recently she has exhibited in project spaces at Wallspace Gallery in New York and Susanne Vielmetter Projects in Los Angeles.
